

**RULES AND CHECK IN PROCEDURES FOR LODI AGRICULTURAL FAIR**  
**LIVESTOCK EXHIBITORS – DATES JULY 9-12, 2009**

1. Swine – Due to recommendations/concerns from USDA/APHIS regarding the H1N1 virus, The Lodi Ag Fair Board has made the decision to make the LAF swine show a **TERMINAL SHOW**. Sorry for any inconvenience. Any questions or concerns please contact Lodi Agricultural Fair.
2. Swine – Animal identification on the health certificate must match the identification of the animal. These records will be supplied to the State Veterinarian.
3. Check In times are from 2-6PM, July 9<sup>th</sup>. All trailers/exhibitors are to enter the fairgrounds at the back entrance off of Hill View Street, forming a line for check in. No livestock trailers will be allowed in any of the front gates.
4. All livestock (swine, cattle, sheep) will be examined and checked in on the trailer. No animals are to be unloaded until permission is given from staff.
5. Sheep must have blankets/tubes off at check in.
6. All livestock **MUST** be identified with a **PERMANENT ID (eartag, tattoo or ear notch)**.
7. All livestock entries must have a premise ID written on their entry form.
8. Any health issues in regards to the livestock on exhibit must be reported to the superintendent/fair office. A veterinarian will be contacted by LAF.
